MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be an incoming full-time freshman for the fall semester of 2017.
- Applicant must be a 2017 graduate from a High School within the OceanFirst Bank footprint. Please refer to page 3 for a list of eligible high schools and sending districts.
- Applicant must currently reside within the geographic boundary of one of the eligible high school districts listed on page 3.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 at the time of application for admission and must provide a copy of their high school transcript.

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship recipients may only use the scholarship for direct educational expenses.

SELECTION

Each College/University will evaluate all scholarship applications received and select recipients based on the College/University's existing policies and procedures for awarding scholarships. Selection decisions are made completely independent of OceanFirst Foundation. Representatives from OceanFirst Bank and OceanFirst Foundation, including all employees and board members, do not participate in the selection process.

Please note that if you are selected to receive an OceanFirst Scholarship, you will receive an invitation to OceanFirst's Scholarship Recognition Event to be held in summer 2017. Your attendance is strongly encouraged.

TO APPLY

Complete the application and mail to the appropriate College/University address noted below. You must provide a copy of your high school transcript. If applying to Ocean County College, you are also required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which can be found at www.fafsa.gov. Your application must be received by May 1, 2017 to be considered for this scholarship. We highly recommend you contact the school to which you are applying to confirm the receipt of your application.
